Angkor Facts

- Angkor was the capital of the Khmer Empire from the 9th to the 15th centuries.
- Angkor was inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage on 14 December 1992.
- Angkor is the biggest World Heritage Site in the World.
- Today, Angkor Wat is among the largest religious monuments in the world.
- With about 1 million habitants, Angkor was the biggest city in the world during the 12th century.
- Until today, the Western Baray is the biggest human-made water reservoir in the world
- The APSARA National Authority was created in 1995 for the conservation and sustainable development of Angkor.
- Angkor is still today a living site where some 100,000 inhabitants are living in 112 villages and hamlets spread throughout the 401 km²
- Angkor still remains a vibrant religious site where monks and Cambodian people come to worship.
- Cambodia's flag is the only flag in the world that features a UNESCO World Heritage Site: Angkor Wat.
